1. Second reading of an ordinance amending the personnel policy and procedure manual of the City of Fremont to include changes to Section 5.18 regarding City Recreation Passes for non-union employees and certain elected city officials.
2. First reading of an ordinance amending appropriations within General Fund 101.
3. First reading of an ordinance authorizing a fund transfer in the amount of \$6,113.29 from General Fund 101 to Walsh Trust Fund 701.
4. First reading of a resolution authorizing the approval and issuance of a warrant for payment of \$3,199.56 to Badger Meter, and declaring an emergency.
5. First reading of an ordinance to authorize the expenditure and direct the Safety Service Director to enter into a change order to GMP Amendment no. 3, with the construction firm MWH Constructors, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$431,000.00 for commissioning and startup costs in accordance with Alternate #1 in Exhibit K for improvements to the Water Pollution Control Center in Fremont, State of Ohio and declaring an emergency.

First reading an ordinance authorizing the Safety Service Director to purchase a minimum of 90 percent up to a maximum of 110 percent of the estimated salt tonnage requirements of the City of Fremont for 2015-2016 through the State of Ohio Department of Transportation's Cooperative Purchasing Program, Winter Salt Contract (#018-16); waiving competitive bidding, and declaring an emergency.
