


The special meeting of Fremont City Council was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in the form prescribed by the General Rules of Council. President Dallas Leake called the meeting to order.

The following members answered roll call: Knisely, Ruiz, Stout, Gross, Koebel, and Michles. Council member Kreilick was absent.

Third reading of an ordinance authorizing the expenditure and directing the Mayor and the Safety Service Director to enter into a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) Amendment to the contract with the construction firm MWH Constructors, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$1,618,847.94 for the Fremont Ballville Dam Project, State of Ohio and declaring an emergency. On a motion to adopt by Knisely, seconded by Ruiz. Mr. Koebel urged the council to put an addendum to the ordinance that would protect the city from the two lawsuits that are pending. Mayor Ellis said that he did not think that it was necessary to attach addendum. The administrators will do their best to keep the City out of risk. After discussion amongst council the ordinance was put to a vote. Motion carried 4 yes votes to 2 no votes. (Ord. 2015-3776)

On motion to adjourn by Knisely, seconded by Ruiz, motion carried 6 yea votes. Meeting adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
