

RESOLUTION NO. 2014- 1927

**AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, OHIO, TO ENTER INTO THE BRIDGE INSPECTION PROGRAM SERVICES FOR PID NO. 97103 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fremont, Ohio desires to enter into a contract for the Bridge Inspection Program Services with the Ohio Department of Transportation (hereinafter referred to as ODOT) in PID No. 97103, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fremont has determined the need for the Bridge Inspection Program Services, including, but not limited to bridge load rating calculations, scour assessments, annual bridge inspections, and fracture critical plan development, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fremont needs the Safety Service Director to sign an agreement as a prerequisite for the City of Fremont to participate in the program at no expense.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO,**

**SECTION 1.** That the Safety Service Director is hereby authorized to sign an agreement with ODOT for Bridge Inspection Program Services for PID No. 97103.

**SECTION 2.** This program is in the public interest; therefore, Fremont City Council hereby authorizes the Safety Service Director to give consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the Bridge Inspection Program Services.

**SECTION 3.** The State shall assume and bear 100% of all of the cost for Bridge Inspection Program Services requested by the City and agreed to by the State. Eligible Bridge Inspection Services are described in the Consultant's Scope of Services Task Order Contract.

**SECTION 4.** The City of Fremont agrees to pay 100% of the cost of those features which are not included in the contract.


**SECTION 5.** The City of Fremont shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in facilitating the program.

**SECTION 6.** The City of Fremont agrees that all right-of-way required for the described program will be made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations.

**SECTION 7.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

**SECTION 8.** The immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need to administer the program in a timely manner.

This resolution, provided it receives a two-thirds yeas or nays vote of all the members elected to the Fremont City Council, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council of the City of Fremont, approval by the Safety Service Director, and publication and posting as required by law.




