

RESOLUTION NO. 2014- 1937

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION FOR SUBMISSION TO THE OHIO DEVELOPMENT SERVICES AGENCY, OFFICE OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ("CDBG") ALLOCATION PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has funds available through the Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Allocation Program for dissemination to eligible cities and counties on an allocation basis, and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Development Services Agency, Office of Community Development, is accepting applications from these cities and counties to access funds, and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Development Services Agency, Office of Community Development, has determined the City of Fremont is eligible for funds in the amount of \$75,000 for CDBG eligible activities, and

WHEREAS, two public hearings are required to be held to receive public input for the application prior to submission to the Ohio Development Services Agency, Office of Community Development. The public hearings were held April 7, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. and May 29, 2014 at 10:00 a.m.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit a grant application to the Ohio Development Services Agency, Office of Community Development, for the fiscal year 2014 Allocation CDBG Program.

SECTION 2. That \$51,800.00 be applied to the 2015 CDBG Dickinson Street Waterline Improvements; \$11,200 to the Community Work Program Public Services; \$2,000 to Fair Housing; and \$10,000 to Administration.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SECTION 4. The immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need to file an application with the Ohio Development Services Agency, Office of Community Development, by the deadline of June 20, 2014.

This resolution, provided it receives a two-thirds yea or nay vote of all the members elected to the Fremont City Council, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council of the City of Fremont, approval by the Mayor, and publication and posting as required by law.


