

ORDINANCE NO. 2016 - 3813

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN
COMMUNITY HOUSING FUND 261, AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City has entered into a joint cooperating agreement with Sandusky County regarding the administration of Fiscal Year 2015 Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) program and;

WHEREAS, the City has agreed to be responsible in administering the grant. This administration includes managing program income from the City, County, and the original 2016 appropriations not included in the County's program income amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. An increase to appropriations within the following fund:

<u>Community Housing Fund 261</u>	
All other	\$59,200.00

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SECTION 3. The immediate operation of the provisions of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need to appropriate the funds for payment of grant expenses in a timely manner.

This ordinance, provided it receives a two-thirds yea or nay vote of all the members elected to the Fremont City Council, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council of the City of Fremont, approval by the Mayor, and publication and posting as required by law.
