

RESOLUTION NO. 2016- 1976

**A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO R.C. §721.15(D) AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH GOVDEALS, INC. ALLOWING THE CITY OF FREMONT TO CONDUCT INTERNET AUCTIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, GovDeals, Inc. is an internet auction site that services a wide variety of government entities for the purposes of selling various items; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fremont has a need to sell various items; and

**WHEREAS**, GovDeals, Inc., has requested from the Safety Service Director, a Memorandum of Understanding, which details a bidding period of ten days and selects a payment option; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO:**


**SECTION 1.** That City Council finds it in the best interest of the City of Fremont to conduct online auctions.

**SECTION 2.** That the Safety Service Director is hereby authorized to execute the Memorandum of Understanding, comply with a bidding period of ten days, select a payment option, and determine all other general terms and conditions of sales.

**SECTION 2.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

**SECTION 3.** The immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont, said emergency being the need to begin the online auction in an expeditious manner.

This resolution, provided it receives a two-thirds yea or nay vote of all the members elected to the Fremont City Council, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council of the City of Fremont, approval by the Mayor, and publication and posting as required by law.
