

RESOLUTION 2017 - 2010

**A RESOLUTION BY THE FREMONT CITY COUNCIL ENDORSING
AND SUPPORTING PASSAGE OF THE FREMONT CITY SCHOOL
LEVY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Fremont City Council recognizes the need for strong schools which will benefit the quality of education for all current and future children living in the School District; and

WHEREAS, Fremont City Council recognizes the current facilities are in dire need of repair and upgrading; and

WHEREAS, Fremont City Council recognizes the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission (OCC) is willing to partner with the School District and provide financial assistance in order to build new facilities; and

WHEREAS, Fremont City Council recognizes this levy will substantially improve the overall quality of education for all children of the City of Fremont while costing the average homeowner about fourteen dollars and fifty-eight cents (\$14.58) per month or approximately \$175.00 dollars a year;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FREMONT CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. City Council does hereby endorse and support passage of the Fremont City School Levy as it will provide an improved quality of education for the students and better equip those who teach our children.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SECTION 3. The immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need for Fremont City Council to endorse passage prior to the May 2nd primary.


This Resolution provided it receives a two-thirds vote of yea or nay of all the members elected to the Fremont City Council, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council of the City of Fremont and approval by the Mayor, and publication and posting as required by law.


