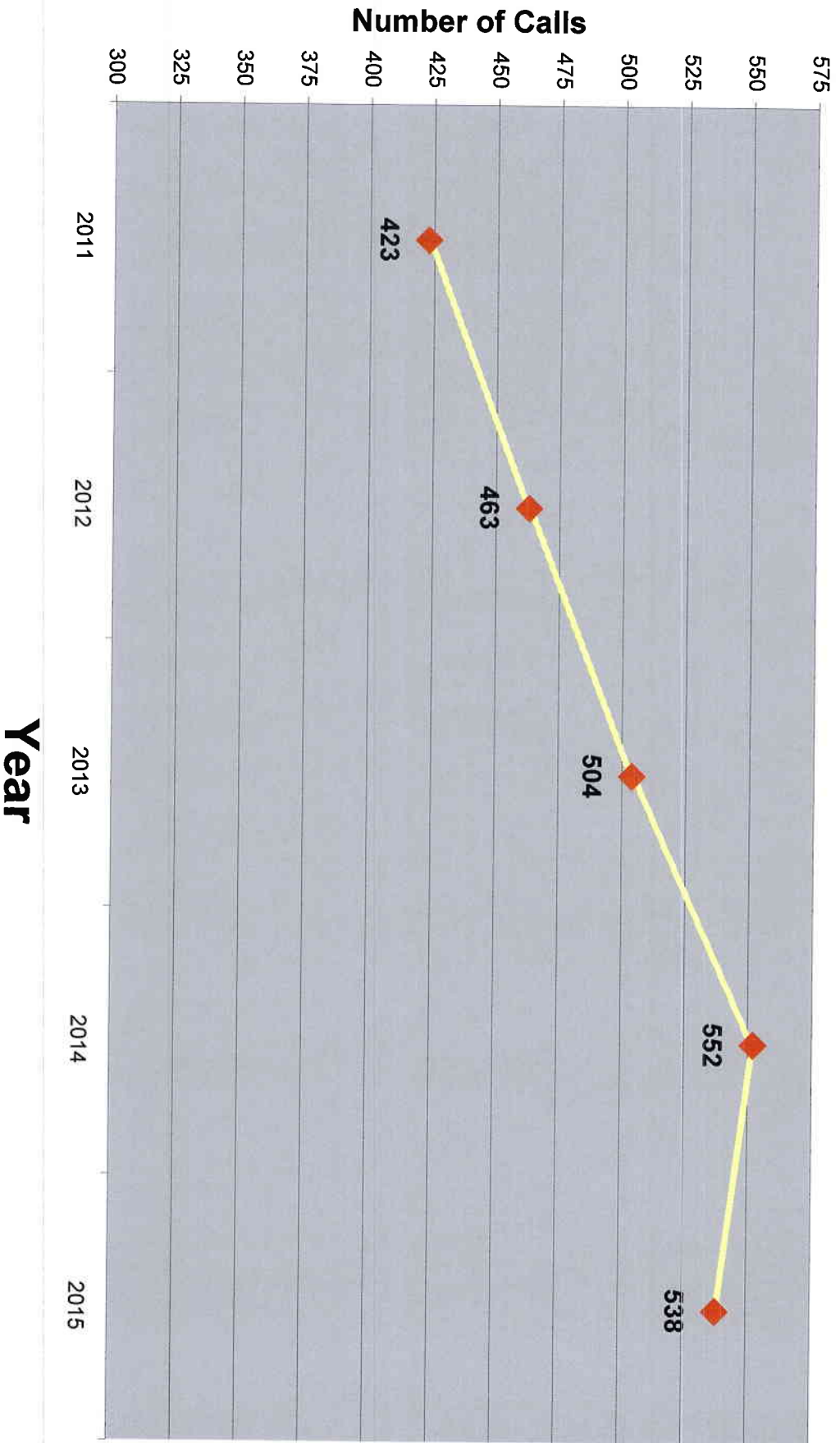

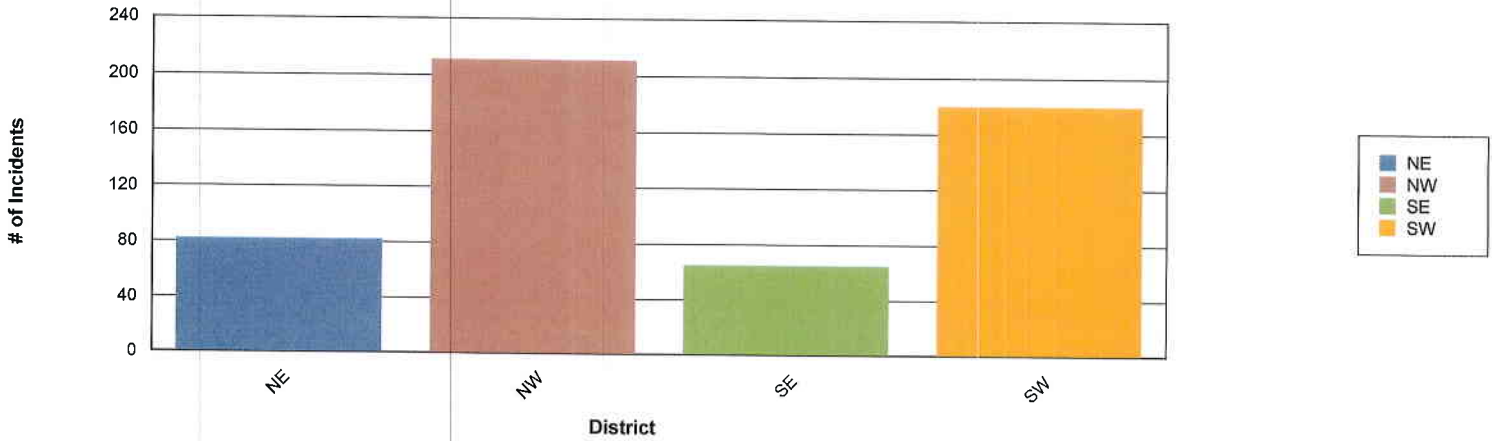

Incidents by District



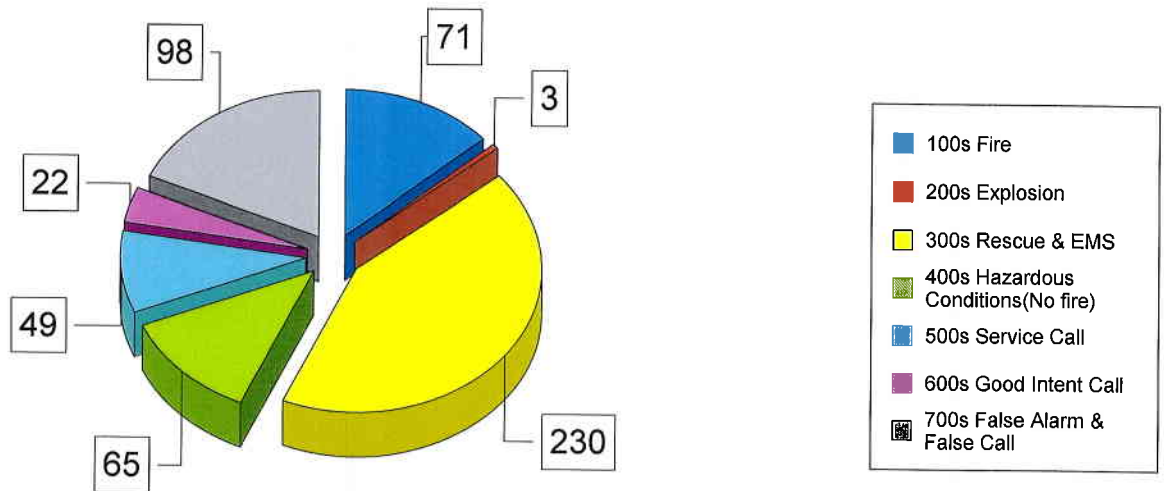

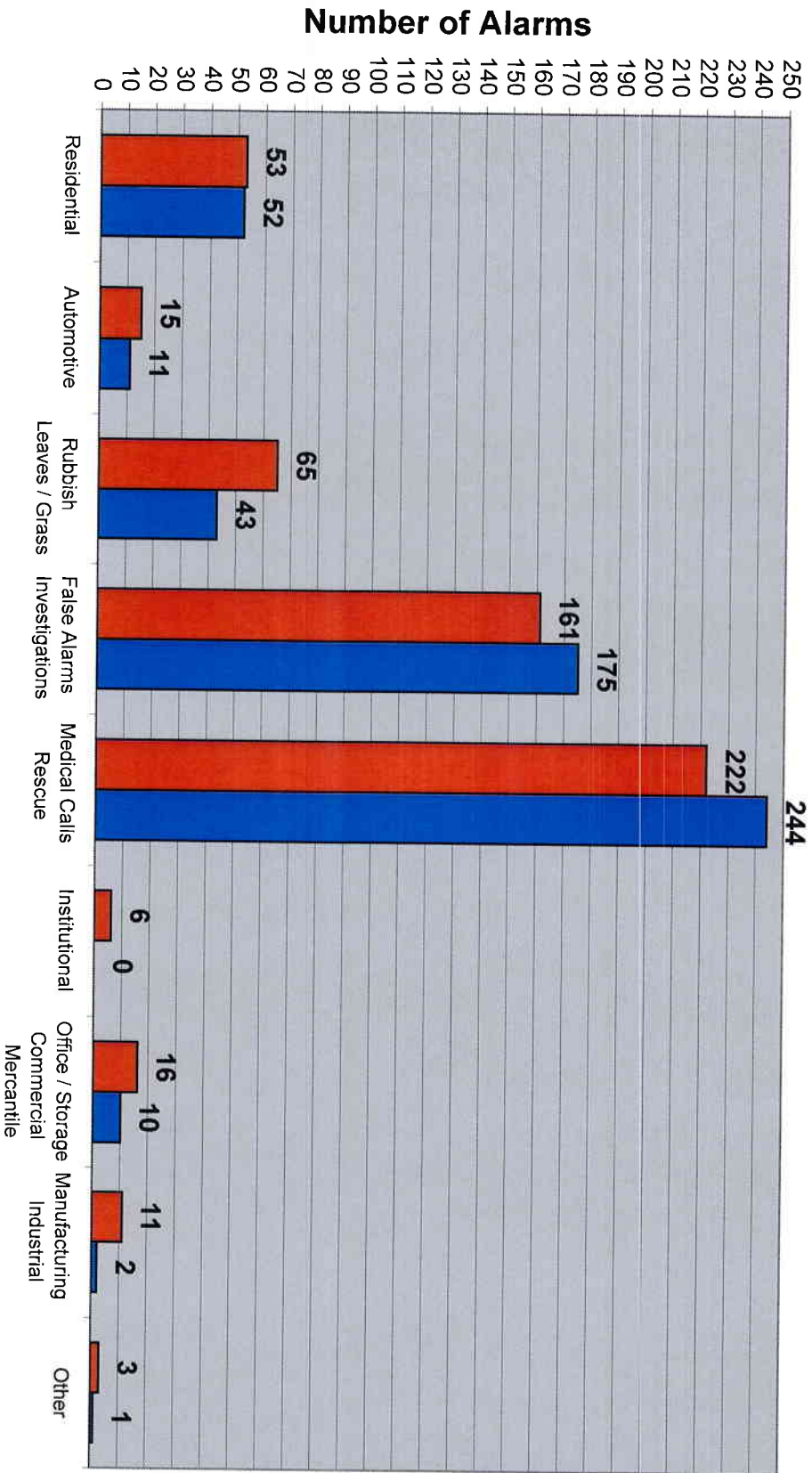

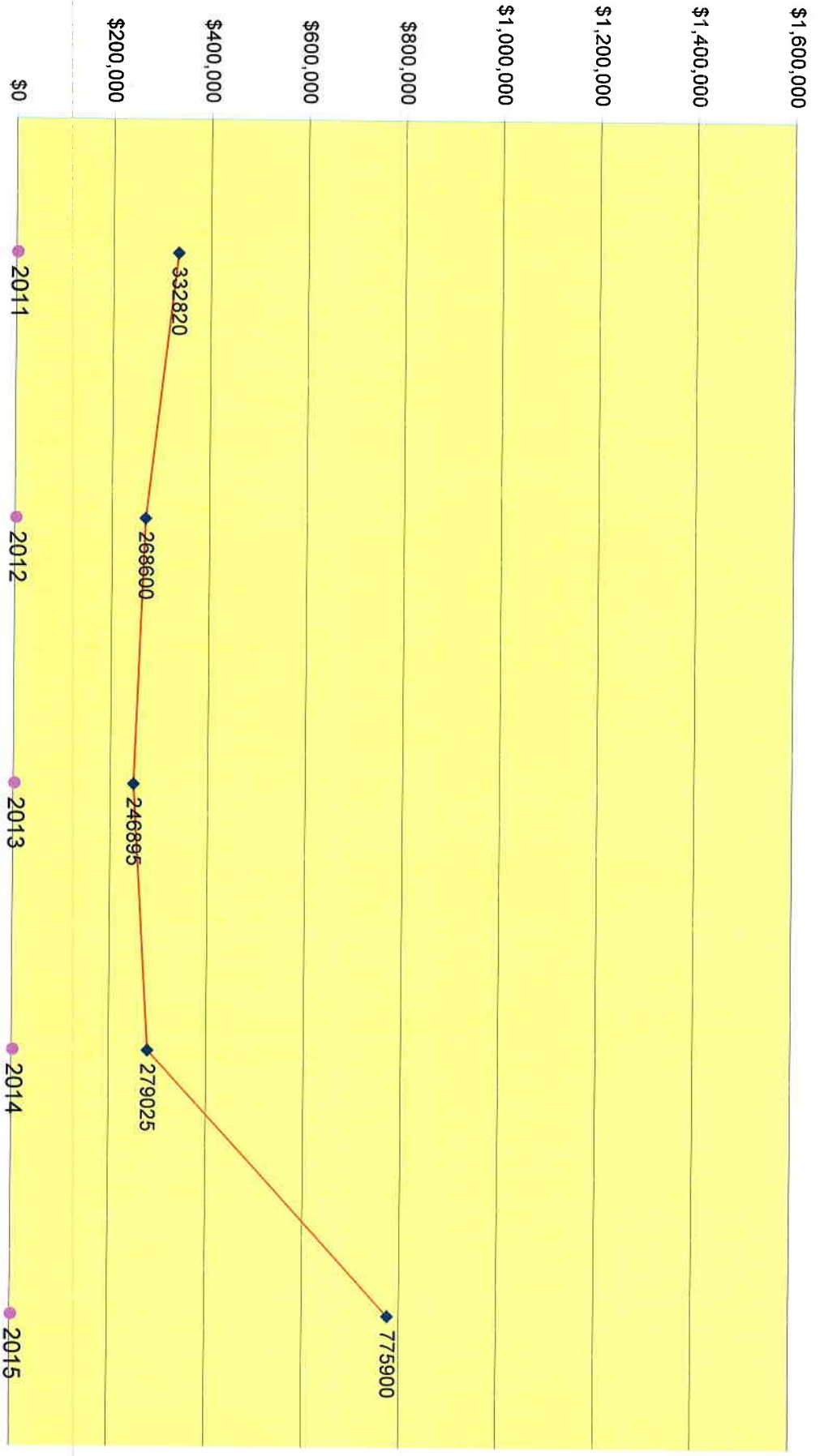
