COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS
FOR TERM: 2012-2013

1. CITIZENS SERVICE COMMITTEE
Review and monitor all services provided by our City other than utilities and traffic.
Environmental issues are also assigned to this committee.
Run or select a person for the Block Watch program.

2. COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP COMMITTEE
Meet with representatives from all school boards and any community organizations or businesses to discuss and promote issues concerning our community.

3. FINANCE & LABOR COMMITTEE
Review and make recommendations related to budgeting and other financial issues which pertain to the operation and provision of funds needed for the City.
Labor as it pertains to funding issues only.

4. GOVERNMENT & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE
Establish and maintain a positive relationship with county, townships and other governmental and related entities. Monitor economic development within the City.

5. LAWS, RULES & ORDINANCES COMMITTEE
Review, develop and implement laws, rules and ordinances as they pertain to the needs of the City.

6. PARKS & RECREATION COMMITTEE
Review and recommend to City Council the recreational needs and desires of the citizens of Fremont through the use of facilities, parks and activities.
Work with the parks and recreation advisory board to promote all activities and events.

7. UTILITIES & TRAFFIC COMMITTEE
Review and address all issues pertaining to utility uses and traffic concerns.
