

RESOLUTION 2012 - 1833

A RESOLUTION BY THE FREMONT CITY COUNCIL ENDORSING AND SUPPORTING PASSAGE OF THE SANDUSKY COUNTY MENTAL HEALTH LEVY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Fremont City Council recognizes the need for quality mental health and recovery services that will benefit all sectors of the County's population, including children, families, seniors, public safety personnel, and veterans; and

WHEREAS, Fremont City Council recognizes the financial benefit of properly funding these services in the community, as it is much more cost-effective to provide treatment through a properly funded mental health and recovery services board than through the legal system; and

WHEREAS, Fremont City Council recognizes this levy will substantially improve the overall quality of life for all residents of Sandusky County, while costing the average homeowner about two dollars (\$2.00) per month;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FREMONT CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. City Council does hereby endorse and support the passage of the Sandusky County Mental Health Levy, as the levy will provide critical services for law enforcement and public safety personnel, a safer environment and more opportunities for our families and children, improved quality of life for our senior citizens and vital treatment and services for those that deserve it most, our soldiers and veterans.

SECTION 2. The immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need for Fremont City Council to endorse passage prior to the March 6th primary election.






