

RESOLUTION NO 2012- 1839

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT INNOVATION FUND GRANT TO THE STATE OF OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, Department of Development, provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for local government innovations projects; and

WHEREAS, a need has been identified to do a feasibility study to evaluate the consolidation of the County Courts in Woodville and Clyde and Fremont Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fremont desires to collaborate with Sandusky County to receive financial assistance to address the needs identified; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fremont has the authority to apply for financial assistance and to administer the amounts received from the State of Ohio, Department of Development; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to sign and submit an application for a Local Government Innovation Fund grant to the Ohio Department of Development.

SECTION 2. That the Council of the City of Fremont hereby understands and agrees that participation in the Program will require compliance with program guidelines and assurances.

SECTION 3. The immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need to meet the application deadline of March 1, 2012.




