

**RESOLUTION NO 2012- 1840**

**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN EXECUTED PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT WITH SANDUSKY COUNTY TO COMPLETE A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF CONSOLIDATING THE COUNTY COURTS IN WOODVILLE & CLYDE AND FREMONT MUNICIPAL COURT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio, Department of Development, provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for local government innovations projects; and

**WHEREAS**, a need has been identified to do a feasibility study to evaluate the consolidation of the County Courts in Woodville & Clyde and Fremont Municipal Court; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fremont desires to collaborate with Sandusky County to receive financial assistance to address the needs identified; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fremont has the authority to apply for financial assistance and to administer the amounts received from the State of Ohio, Department of Development; and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Fremont desires to enter into a partnership agreement with Sandusky County to complete a feasibility study of consolidating the county and municipal courts; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO,**

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is authorized to sign a partnership agreement with Sandusky County to use Local Government Innovation Fund grant money to complete a feasibility study of consolidating the County Courts in Woodville & Clyde and Fremont Municipal Court.

**SECTION 2.** The immediate operation of the provisions of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need to meet the application deadline of March 1, 2012.




