

ORDINANCE NO. 2013 - 3648

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN ADVANCE OF \$550,000.00 FROM FUND 201 (MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX) TO FUND 420 (FIRE EQUIPMENT), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The Fremont City Council of Fremont, State of Ohio, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. City Council hereby authorizes the advance of funds totaling \$550,000 as listed below:

SECTION 2. That until additional funding for the purchase of one (1) SL75 Quint Fire Fighting Apparatus and one (1) SP95 Remount Platform Fire Fighting Apparatus has been obtained, an advance of funds from the Municipal Income Tax Fund 201 to the Fire Equipment Fund 420 is necessary to allow the City Auditor to certify the availability of funds for the fire-fighting apparatuses, and once additional funding has been obtained the amounts advanced will be repaid.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SECTION 4. The immediate operation of the provisions of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need to for the Auditor to certify the availability of funds for the purchase agreement of said fire fighting apparatuses.

This ordinance, provided it receives a two-thirds yea or nay vote of all the members elected to the Fremont City Council, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council of the City of Fremont, approval by the Mayor, and publication and posting as required by law.


