

ORDINANCE NO. 2013- 3670

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE THE GRANT AWARDED FROM OHIO CDBG IN THE AMOUNT OF \$75,000 TO FUND NO. 260 (OHIO CDBG) AND TO APPROPRIATE THE CITY'S CONTRIBUTION OF \$33,200 TO FUND NO. 410 (CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Fremont received a grant from the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) in the amount of \$75,000.00. The State of Ohio, Office of Community Development, has made said funds available to the City of Fremont, and it is now necessary to appropriate said funds to Fund No. 260 Ohio CDBG; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fremont, as a condition of the grant, is contributing an additional \$33,200.00 to the Program Budget for the Middle Street Project, and it is now necessary to appropriate said funds to Fund No. 410 Capital Improvement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL, CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. The \$75,000.00 made available to the City of Fremont by the State of Ohio, Office of Community Development grant, be appropriated to Fund No. 260 Ohio CDBG.

SECTION 2. The \$33,200.00 to be contributed by the City for the Middle Street Project, be appropriated to Fund No. 410 Capital Improvement.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.


SECTION 4. The immediate operation of the provisions of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need to appropriate the funds for payment of grant expenses in a timely manner.




