

RESOLUTION NO. 2012- 1876

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE OSS SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the OSS Solid Waste Management District has funds available for the purchase of products made from at least 25% recycled materials, and

WHEREAS, the OSS Solid Waste Management District has determined that the City of Fremont is eligible for funds in the amount of \$8,500.00 for the purchase of products made from at least 25% recycled materials, and

WHEREAS, the OSS Solid Waste Management District has requested authorization from the Mayor, in the form of a letter, to purchase the 25% recycled materials, and receive reimbursement from OSS Solid Waste Management District,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to issue a letter to OSS Solid Waste Management District authorizing the purchase of the 25% recycled materials, and

SECTION 2. The appropriations in Fund 410 shall be increased by \$8,500.00 and allocated as follows: \$2,170.00 be applied to the purchase of a sign for the WPCC Project; \$2,337.82 be applied to the purchase of trash receptacles for the Parks Department; and \$3,992.18 to the purchase of materials for the Streets Department.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SECTION 4. The immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need to utilize the grant dollars immediately, or risk losing access to the funds.

This resolution, provided it receives a two-thirds yea or nay vote of all the members elected to the Fremont City Council, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council of the City of Fremont, approval by the Mayor, and publication and posting as required by law.






