1. Third Reading – A resolution authorizing the approval and issuance of a warrant for payment of \$5,176.80 to ASCO Services Inc. and declaring an emergency
  2. Second Reading – An ordinance authorizing the mayor to execute on behalf of the city of Fremont a settlement agreement between the city and Marvin Dabish (DBA) The Players’ Club Internet Café and in connection with case # 3:12CV146 in U.S. District Court of the Northern District of Ohio, Western Division, and to execute all documents and take action as required under the agreement, and declaring an emergency.
  3. Second Reading – An ordinance enacting a new Chapter 749 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Fremont titled Sweepstakes Terminal Café, and declaring an emergency.
  4. Action on Fremont Country Club’s D5I liquor license
  5. First Reading – An ordinance to appropriate \$2,051.55 to Street Fund and declaring an emergency.
