  - Approve minutes of September 19 meeting
1. Third reading of an ordinance to transfer \$1,754,728.00 from Water Fund 510 to Water Reservoir Fund 542, and declaring an emergency.
  2. Third reading of an ordinance to authorize the expenditure and direct the Safety Service Director to enter into a change order with the engineering firm MWH Americas Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$288,500.00 for improvements to the Fremont Water Pollution Control Center in Fremont, and declaring an emergency.
  3. Third reading of an ordinance approving the editing and inclusion of certain ordinances as part of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of Fremont, Ohio and to amend or enact sections of the traffic, general offenses & fire prevention codes to conform to enactments of the General Assembly.
  4. First reading of an ordinance authorizing the mayor to enter into a grant agreement with Ohio Development Services Agency for fiscal year 2013 for Community Development Block Grant program (CDBG) and declaring an emergency.
  5. First reading of an ordinance to amend Sec. 3 of Ord. 2013-3641 to read that all residential property owners outside the boundaries of the municipalities affected by the expansion of the Hayes Avenue waterline project may request a water tap and shall not be subject to the annexation covenant for the city of Fremont.
  6. First reading of an ordinance to authorize the expenditure and direct the Safety Service Director to enter into a contract with the engineering firm MWH Americas Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$1 million for construction services to improve the Fremont Water Pollution Control Center in Fremont, State of Ohio, and declaring an emergency.
  7. First reading of an ordinance to authorize the expenditure and direct the Safety Service Director to enter into a contract with Cutter Green for an amount not to exceed \$6,100 for remediation of the property at 425 N. Wood St., Fremont, State of Ohio, and declaring an emergency.
  8. First reading of a resolution authorizing the approval and issuance of a warrant for payment of \$9,216.00 to Stantec Consulting Services Inc., and declaring an emergency.
  9. First reading of a resolution authorizing the approval and issuance of a warrant for payment of \$9,821.00 to Stantec Consulting Services Inc., and declaring an emergency.
  10. First reading of a resolution authorizing the mayor to apply for, accept, and enter into a loan for construction, maintenance, and operations of a state water project or waste water project on behalf of the city of Fremont for construction of Phase 2 of a waste water treatment facility up to the principal sum of \$1,880,671.53 and designating a dedicated repayment source for the loan, and declaring an emergency.
