 - Approve minutes of September 20 meeting
1. Third reading of a resolution authorizing the approval and issuance of a warrant of payment of \$4,522.76 to Robinson, Curphey & O'Connell, a declaring an emergency.
 2. Third reading of a resolution authorizing the appropriation and transfer of funds from the Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) to the General Fund in the amount of \$20,000 to be used for economic development through the Big Fremont Plan, and declaring an emergency.

 6. First reading of a resolution authorizing the approval and issuance of a warrant for payment of \$6,396.88 to American Arbitration Associates, and declaring an emergency.
 7. First reading of an ordinance authorizing the mayor to enter into an agreement with Champion energy Services for electric generation services in Fremont, State of Ohio, and declaring an emergency.
