

RESOLUTION NO. 2018- 2063

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION FOR SUBMISSION TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) has funds available through the Land and Water Conservation Fund for the acquisition or development of a public park, and

WHEREAS, Grant allows for funds up to \$500,000 to political subdivisions to be used by municipality to enhance public parks, and

WHEREAS, Parks and Recreations departments have a need for park improvements, Fremont's monetary obligation will be determined based upon the extent of the award, and

WHEREAS, ODNR is accepting applications until November 15th, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to submit a grant application to the ODNR for the Land and Water Conservation Fund.

SECTION 2. Any grant funds obtained will be used by the Fremont Parks and Recreation departments for the improvement of Birchard Park.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SECTION 4. The immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need to file application with the ODNR by the deadline of November 15th, 2018.

This resolution, provided it receives a two-thirds yea or nay vote of all the members elected to the Fremont City Council, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council of the City of Fremont, approval by the Mayor, and publication and posting as required by law.
