

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-0079**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES (ODNR) FOR THE STATE OF OHIO CAPITAL GRANT PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio has funds available through the State Capital grant program for dissemination to the City of Fremont, and

**WHEREAS**, ODNR is requiring the City to enter into an agreement to participate in the program, and

**WHEREAS**, ODNR has determined the City of Fremont is eligible for funds in the amount of \$276,000 for enumerated developments for the Upland Reservoir Paving Project, Rodger Young Park Tennis Courts, North Coast Inland Trail and the Sand Docks Improvements.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement to participate in the grant program.

**SECTION 2.** The City is eligible to receive an award of up to \$276,000 for State Capital Program recreational improvement projects.

**SECTION 3.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

**SECTION 4.** The immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need to enter into Agreement with the ODNR prior to construction of the improvements.

This resolution, provided it receives a two-thirds yea or nay vote of all the members elected to the Fremont City Council, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council of the City of Fremont, approval by the Mayor, and publication and posting as required by law.
