1. Third reading of a resolution adopting and authorizing the implementation of a Citizens' Participation Plan as part of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) procedures.
2. First reading of an ordinance amending appropriations within Capital Improvement Fund 410, and declaring an emergency.
3. First reading of an ordinance establishing uniform benefits for non-union employees of the City of Fremont at the discretion of the Safety Service Director and declaring an emergency.
4. First reading of a resolution authorizing the approval and issuance of a warrant for payment of \$186,235.17 to Oriana House, Inc., and declaring an emergency.
