

ORDINANCE NO. 2020 - 4016

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE COMBINED GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT AMENDED AGREEMENT AND PURSUANT TO SAID AGREEMENT APPOINTING ROBERT GROSS AND DR. REGINA VINCENT WILLIAMS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, R.C. §3709.01 provides each city within the State of Ohio constitutes a health district known as a "city health district" and the townships and villages within each county are combined into a health district known as a "general health district"; and

WHEREAS, R.C. §3709.01 authorizes one or more city health districts to unite with a general health district in the formation of a single district; and

WHEREAS, effective September, 1957, by agreement, ("Agreement") the District Advisory Council for the Sandusky County General Health District, the Board of Commissioners, Sandusky County, Ohio and the cities of Clyde and Fremont established a combined general health district known as the Sandusky County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement has not been amended; however, the parties recognize an amended agreement is necessary to ensure the board is lawfully established as a Combined Health District under R.C. §3709; and

WHEREAS, under the original document, titled Contract for Union of City Health District Creating a Combined Board of Health, the City of Clyde, Ohio and the City of Fremont, Ohio entered into an agreement effective in 1957, to unite with the Sandusky County General Health District as a party to the combined general health district; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the Agreement require updating and additional provisions added to ensure legal compliance; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 5b of the Agreement, the Mayor may appoint two (2) members to the board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL, CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Combined General Health District Amended Agreement and appoint Robert Gross and Dr. Regina Vincent Williams to serve on the board.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SECTION 3. The immediate operation of the provisions of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need to execute the agreement prior to the April 17th meeting which will require voting by the prospective members.

This ordinance, provided it receives a two-thirds yea or nay vote of all the members elected to the Fremont City Council, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council of the City of Fremont, approval by the Mayor, and publication and posting as required by law.


