Fremont Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area



**The Mayor of the City of Fremont, with the support of the Downtown Fremont, Inc. respectfully submits
the following application to Fremont City Council in accordance with ORD 4301.82**

Submitted September 11, 2020

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1.0 Introduction/Overview

The Mayor Daniel R. Sanchez on behalf of Downtown Fremont, Inc. (DFI), a 501c(3) Non-Profit Organization, has submitted this application to Fremont City Council to approve and enact the Fremont Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area (DORA), in accordance with Section 4301.82(D)(3) of the Ohio Revised Code. This allows municipalities with a population under 35,000 residents to create a Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area that is no larger than 150 contiguous acres in size. Fremont City Council approval would create a Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area within a large portion of the Historic Downtown Fremont and a small area outside the Historic Downtown Fremont District, meeting the requirements of ORC 4301.82, for the economic and cultural betterment of the businesses, residents and property owners within the DORA, as well as the whole of Fremont by further establishing Fremont's Historic Downtown District as a destination for entertainment, culture, and other civic activity.

The application filing must be advertised once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation. Council may approve the establishment of the Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area between 30 and 60 days after the application notice is first published.

A DORA is an area where the statutory open container restrictions do not apply at particular hours, and adults are permitted to possess and consume alcohol in an identified area, with certain restrictions. DORA's have already been established in many cities, such as Tiffin, Port Clinton, Napoleon, Defiance, and Toledo.

The City and DFI have strong experience in providing adequate security, public health measures and leadership for large and small events held in Downtown Fremont and would use the experience to manage and enforce rules and administration of the DORA; examples include the Downtown Farmer's Markets, New Year's Eve Celebrations, Cinco de Mayo Festival, Fremont Fish Festival, All Together Fremont, and several parades as major Downtown Fremont events. The DFI Board of Directors and many neighborhood stakeholders are confident that this experience, and our commitment to the overall advancement of Fremont, is the perfect foundation of skills to administer the DORA within Fremont.

As outlined in this Application, the DFI Executive Director and members of the DFI Board will be working with the downtown Fremont stakeholders, Fremont City Council, Safety, Sanitation, and Transportation officials to ensure a safe, professional implementation of the DORA. Through regular communication with all affected city departments and Downtown Fremont stakeholders we will tailor the DORA safety and sanitation needs as time and experience progress, as permitted in ORD 4301.82.

Thank you to the many businesses and building owners within Downtown Fremont, the Mayor of the City of Fremont, City of Fremont Law Director, City of Fremont Safety Service Director, City of Fremont Engineer and Engineering Department, Fremont Police Department, Fremont City Council, and many others for all of the support provided and involvement in developing this application and its ultimate implementation.

2.0 Specific Boundaries of the DORA, including Street Addresses

2.1 Boundary Description

Starting at Chud's on Napoleon St.

- Head west to Monroe St., turn south on Monroe to Croghan St.

- Head east on Croghan (north side only) to Arch St., turn south on Arch (east side only) to Ewing St.
- Head east on Ewing (north side only) to Bidwell Ave., turn north on Bidwell to Croghan St.
- Head west on Croghan to Front St., turn north on Front to State St.
- Head north to cross State St. within the pedestrian cross-walks, turn east over the river on State St. to the last DORA establishment.
- The boundary will then return to the west side by leaving Anthony's and heading west on State St. (north side only) crossing the river, turn south to cross State St. within the pedestrian cross-walks
- Head west on State to Park Ave., turn south (southwest) on Park to Croghan St.
- Head west on Croghan to Lynn St., turn north on Lynn St. to Napoleon returning and ending at Chud's

2.4 Signage

DFI in partnership with the City of Fremont Engineer have determined a minimum of 20 signs are necessary to adequately designate the DORA district. The image was created by a local designer with full knowledge of City of Fremont branding efforts.

This signage program will be finalized with the consideration of a full Wayfinding program for the downtown Fremont area.

Signage will be evaluated on a continual basis, and additional signage will be added to areas needing additional visibility as needed.

3.0 Land Use and Zoning

3.1 Land Use

The land use of parcels within the DORA consist of mostly commercial establishments, except for a small percentage of residential or mixed-use structures. The majority are retail businesses, dining establishments or service businesses. The DORA is within the City of Fremont's downtown business district. There are more than four (4) liquor permit holders within the DORA. Below is a full list of establishments within the DORA that hold liquor permits.

2 social clubs, 6 full-service restaurants, 3 bars, and 2 other (catering/retail)

3.2 Zoning

The majority of the land within the DORA is zoned as B-2 Central Business District. The definition is as follows:

The purpose of the B-2 District is to accommodate extensive commercial uses that require large lots, usually for display and/or outdoor storage purposes, and highway oriented businesses that require highway or thoroughfare frontage for visibility and ready accessibility for their customers who come from a sizeable trade area extending well beyond the City of Fremont.

4.0 Hours of Operations for DORA

DORA will be in operation Monday through Friday, 5:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. and on Saturday & Sunday 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Last call for DORA sales will be 10:45 p.m. at all establishments.

All DORA beverages MUST be finished and disposed of by 11:30 p.m.

All requests to extend or change the hours of operation for special events and/or holiday celebrations must be approved by the City Safety Service Director. New Year's Eve DORA will be extended to 12:30am, annually.

5.0 Public Safety Plan

Safety and Security Plan

The Fremont Police Department commits to the continued patrol and monitoring of Downtown Fremont on the current schedule. This commitment will be tailored to be adequate and sufficient for public safety in an efficient, ongoing basis. There will be a minimum of 2 officers on shift at any given time. There will be a minimum of 3 officers on shift during the evenings on Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays.

It is understood that on-duty officer's first responsibility is to respond to calls of service or reported crime, whether or not those calls are in the DORA.

This security plan will be reviewed continuously, and may be updated at any times, but only with the coordination and approval of the Safety Service Director and Fremont City Council with direct assistance and recommendations of the Fremont Police Department, to ensure public safety at all times is both sufficient and adequate.

If it is determined by City officials that additional security is needed for any reason, the City of Fremont reserves the right to suspend the DORA and Rules of the DORA until any security issues are resolved.

The City of Fremont will keep the speed limit at 25 MPH through the DORA to increase public safety.

Security Plan Review

The Laws, Rules, and Ordinance (LRO) Committee will act as the city's DORA review committee. The LRO, DFI, and the City Safety Service Director will meet regularly, no less than four (4) times during the

first year of operation to review and adjust, if necessary, this Security Plan to ensure Public Safety is maintained. The first such meeting will take place no more than forty-five (45) days after the initial implementation of DORA. It is understood that the general composition of this Security Plan, with approval by Fremont City Council, can be altered or improved at any time. Based on the formal recommendation of the LRO, Fremont City Council has the authority to revoke an establishment's participation in the DORA.

6.0 Sanitation and Public Health

Trash Receptacles:

The City of Fremont owns and maintains trash receptacles throughout the DORA and the City of Fremont Parks Department empties the receptacles on a weekly basis, unless the volume increases on a consistent basis where the schedule would need addressed and modified. The topic of any increased waste concerns will be brought to the City of Fremont City Council meeting when needed.

The establishments that have liquor permits to serve alcohol on their premises shall maintain a trash receptacle of adequate size near the main entrance of the facility. The establishment may request a variance to this requirement in writing to DFI, which would then be taken into consideration with the previously mentioned committee and the Safety Service Director, who may modify this requirement with justification.

Street Sweeping:

The City of Fremont Street Department will continue the current schedule of street sweeping in the DORA.

8.0 Rules of the DORA

Rules of Ohio Substitute House Bill 47:

ORC 4301.62 (C)(7)(a):

A person may have in the person's possession an opened container of beer, wine or intoxicating liquor at an outdoor location with an outdoor refreshment area (ORA) created under section 4301.82 of the Ohio Revised Code if the opened container of beer or intoxicating liquor was purchased from a qualified permit holder to which both of the following apply:

- (i) The permit holder's premises is located within the outdoor refreshment area
- (ii) The permit held by the permit holder has an outdoor refreshment area designation

ORC 4301.62 (C)(7)(b):

Outdoor Refreshment Area Participants may NOT:

- (i) Enter the premises of an establishment within an outdoor refreshment area while possessing an opened container of beer or intoxicating liquor acquired elsewhere;
- (ii) Possess an opened container of beer or intoxicating liquor while being in or on a motor vehicle with an outdoor refreshment area

ORC 4301.82 (F)(1)(g):

ALL beer, wine or intoxicating liquor must be contained in the Official Cup of the DORA. No other container will be permitted.

Additional Rules Specific to the DORA:

- Only one (1) Official Cup will be permitted at a time per DORA participant
- All DORA beverages must be served in a new, unused Official Cup
- Used Official Cups must be disposed of before entering any establishment that serves alcohol in the DORA
- Private property owners reserve the right to prohibit the consumption of alcohol on their property. Adequate signage shall be placed and clearly displayed at owner's expense in order for this rule to be enforced.
- Assumption of Good Behavior by DORA participants:

A participant can expect to enjoy the DORA without restraint, questioning or harassment by Fremont Police Department, the City of Fremont or any DORA entity SO LONG AS the participant correctly follows all the Rules of the DORA, and maintains a decorum of Good Behavior, free of public drunkenness, property destruction or any action that disrupts the enjoyment of another participant, or disrupts any establishment, property owner, resident, visitor, passerby or patron within the DORA.

****Violation of any of these Rules of the Area shall be considered a minor misdemeanor and violators face warnings and/or fines up to \$150.00 in accordance with ORC 4301.62 and Section 529.07 of the Codified Ordinances of Fremont, Ohio.****

****The City of Fremont reserves the right to enforce additional penalties that are in violation of any federal, state or local code, rule or regulation as needed.****

9.0 Official DORA Cup

In accordance with ORC 4301.82(F)(1)(g), beer, wine, and intoxicating liquor shall only be consumed within the DORA as follows:

Beer, wine, and intoxicating liquor shall only be served and consumed in the DORA in the plastic cups or other specifically designated plastic containers produced and provided by DFI (the "Official DORA Cup"). The Official Cup will be distinctly marked with the DORA logo. No other container will be permitted. Used cups must be disposed of before entering any establishment of a qualified permit holder. DORA Cups will be able to hold no more than sixteen (16) fluid ounces, and will be composed of plastic.

The design of the Official DORA Cup shall not show children consuming alcohol, Santa Claus or any other Holiday figure using alcohol, and shall not use sayings or slogans that encourage the consumption of large quantities of alcohol.

The design of the Official DORA Cup may have logos for sponsors. However, the Official Cup shall not have logos from liquor, wine or beer companies or establishments.

If an alcoholic beverage is poured into an Official DORA Cup, then the patron must leave the establishment and may not stay inside of the establishment to consume the beverage.

The Alcohol Establishment Owners/Operators may attach a fee or To-Go Charge on every DORA beverage sold, accompanied by an Official DORA Cup.

The DORA cup will be a 16-ounce clear plastic cup printed with the DORA logo and ORC Rules. The Alcohol Establishment Owners/Operator must purchase the approved DORA cups from DFI at the current providers sell price including any taxes, delivery costs or other charges. Cups must be purchased in quantities not less than 500 per order and must be picked-up by the establishments, providing not less than a 72-hour notice.

If changes to the DORA cup are made, qualified permit holders will be given a 90 day notice of the change.
