A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION FOR SUBMISSION TO THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (OHIO EPA) FOR THE LEVEL 2 ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio EPA has funds available through the Level 2 Electric Vehicle Charging Station Grant for the purchase of equipment needed to enhance public safety, and

WHEREAS, the grant allows for funds up to \$7,500 per single port and \$15,000 per double port networked Level 2 charger, and

WHEREAS, the City has a need for Level 2 electric charging stations, the Ohio EPA will cover 100% of eligible costs if located on government owned property and

WHEREAS, the Ohio EPA is accepting applications until September 30, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to submit a grant application to the Ohio EPA for the Level 2 Electric Vehicle Charging Station Grant.

SECTION 2. Any grant funds obtained will be used by the City for the purchase and installation of Level 2 electric vehicle charging stations.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.


SECTION 4. The immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need to file application with the Ohio EPA by the deadline of September 30, 2020.

This resolution, provided it receives a two-thirds yea or nay vote of all the members elected to the Fremont City Council, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council of the City of Fremont, approval by the Mayor, and publication and posting as required by law.
