

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-4067

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 941 PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS CODE SECTION 941.03(D) RULES AND REGULATIONS OF PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The City desires to amend Chapter 941 Parks and Playgrounds Code Section 941.03(d) Rules and Regulations of Parks and Playgrounds; and

WHEREAS, the amendment proposed is described herein:

Section 941.03(d) which currently reads as follows:

941.03 RULES AND REGULATIONS OF PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS.

(d) Consumption or possession of all alcoholic beverages on the City park premises is prohibited.

Section 941.03(d) shall hereby be amended and now read as follows:

941.03 RULES AND REGULATIONS OF PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS.

(d) Consumption or possession of all alcoholic beverages on the City park premises is prohibited unless prior approval is received from the Safety-Service Director.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. The City desires to amend Chapter 941 Parks and Playgrounds Code Section 941.03 Rules and Regulations of Parks and Playgrounds of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Fremont; therefore, City Council authorizes the amendments to reflect the changes herein by reference.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SECTION 3. The immediate operation of the provisions of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the immediate need to pass the amendment in an expeditious manner.


