

**ORDINANCE NO. 202** 1 - 4086

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN GENERAL FUND 101, PUBLIC RECREATION FUND 211, STREET MAINTENANCE FUND 222, MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE FUND 223, PROBATION SERVICES FUND 232, MANDATORY FINES FUND 252, CDBG FUND 260, WATER OPERATING FUND 510, SEWER OPERATING FUND 570, AND RECREATION TRUST FUND 702, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL, CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** An increase to appropriations within the following funds:

**SECTION 3.** The immediate operation of the provisions of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the immediate need of the aforementioned departments to properly function.


This ordinance, provided it receives a two-thirds yea or nay vote of all the members elected to the Fremont City Council, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council of the City of Fremont, approval by the Mayor, and publication and posting as required by law.
