

ORDINANCE NO. 2022- 4094

AN ORDINANCE TO IMPOSE AN ADDITIONAL ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (0.50%) INCOME TAX ON AND AFTER JANUARY 1ST, 2023 FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE (5) YEARS TO BE USED SOLELY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, REPAIR, IMPROVEMENT, AND MAINTENANCE OF STREETS AND ROADS INCLUDING RELATED DEBT CHARGES WITHIN THE CITY, AND APPURTENANCES THERETO, TO AMEND CHAPTER 172 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FREMONT AS AMENDED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL, CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: Subject to the approval of the electors of the City of Fremont as provided in § 718.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, effective January 1st, 2023 Chapter 172 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Fremont, as amended, is further amended in part, as follows:

- 1. Section 172.01(B)(2) is enacted to read in full as set forth in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. The immediate operation of the provisions of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need to submit to the Sandusky County Board of Elections in a timely fashion to be placed on the May 3rd, 2022 ballot.





EXHIBIT "A"

172.01(B)(2) PURPOSES OF TAX; RATE

Effective January 1st, 2023, in addition to the tax imposed by Section 172.01(B)(1), there is levied an additional tax of one-half of one percent (0.50%) for a period of five (5) years for the sole purpose of construction, repair, improvement, and maintenance of streets and roads including related debt charges in the City and appurtenances thereto.
