

**RESOLUTION 2022 - 2149**

**A RESOLUTION OF FREMONT CITY COUNCIL ENDORSING AND SUPPORTING PASSAGE OF THE STREET LEVY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Fremont City Council recognizes the need for improvements on the streets within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, Fremont City Council recognizes the current streets are in dire need of repair and upgrading; and

**WHEREAS**, Fremont City Council recognizes improving the streets enhances the City, strengthens economic development, and benefits the citizens of Fremont; and

**WHEREAS**, Fremont City Council recognizes this levy will substantially improve the streets within the City of Fremont while costing the average tax payer an additional one-half of one percent (0.50%) beginning January 1, 2023 for a period of five (5) years.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FREMONT CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO:**


**SECTION 1.** City Council does hereby endorse and support passage of the Fremont Street Levy as it will improve the streets within the City limits.

**SECTION 2.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

**SECTION 3.** The immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need for Fremont City Council to endorse passage prior to the May 2nd primary.

This Resolution provided it receives a two-thirds vote of yea or nay of all the members elected to the Fremont City Council, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and

after its passage by the Council of the City of Fremont and approval by the Mayor, and publication and posting as required by law.


